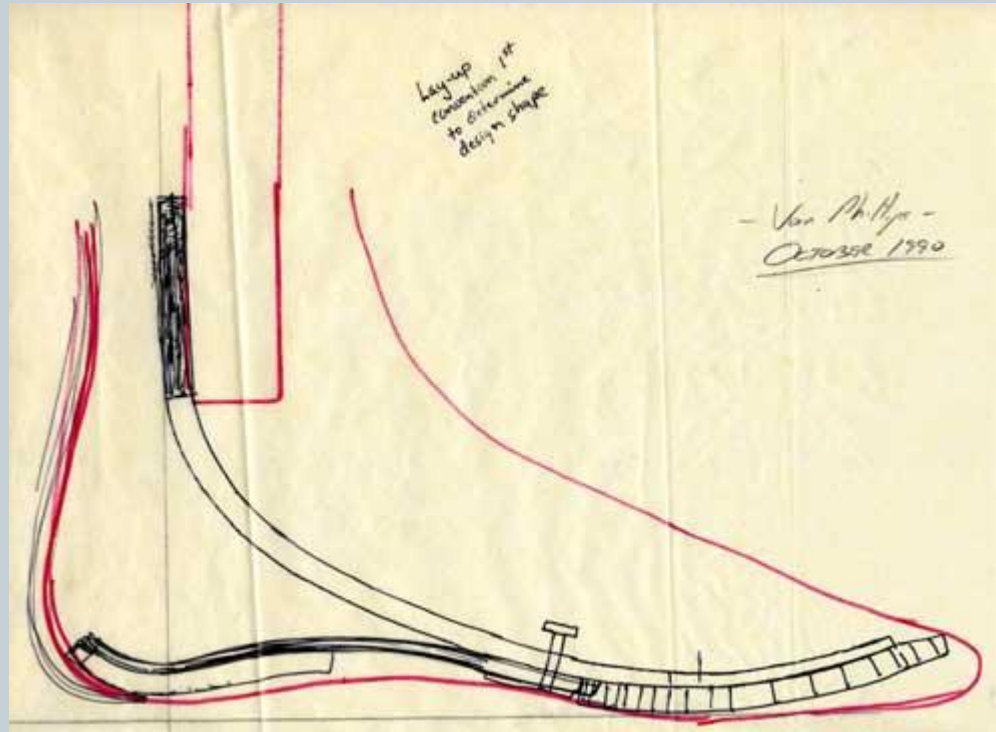

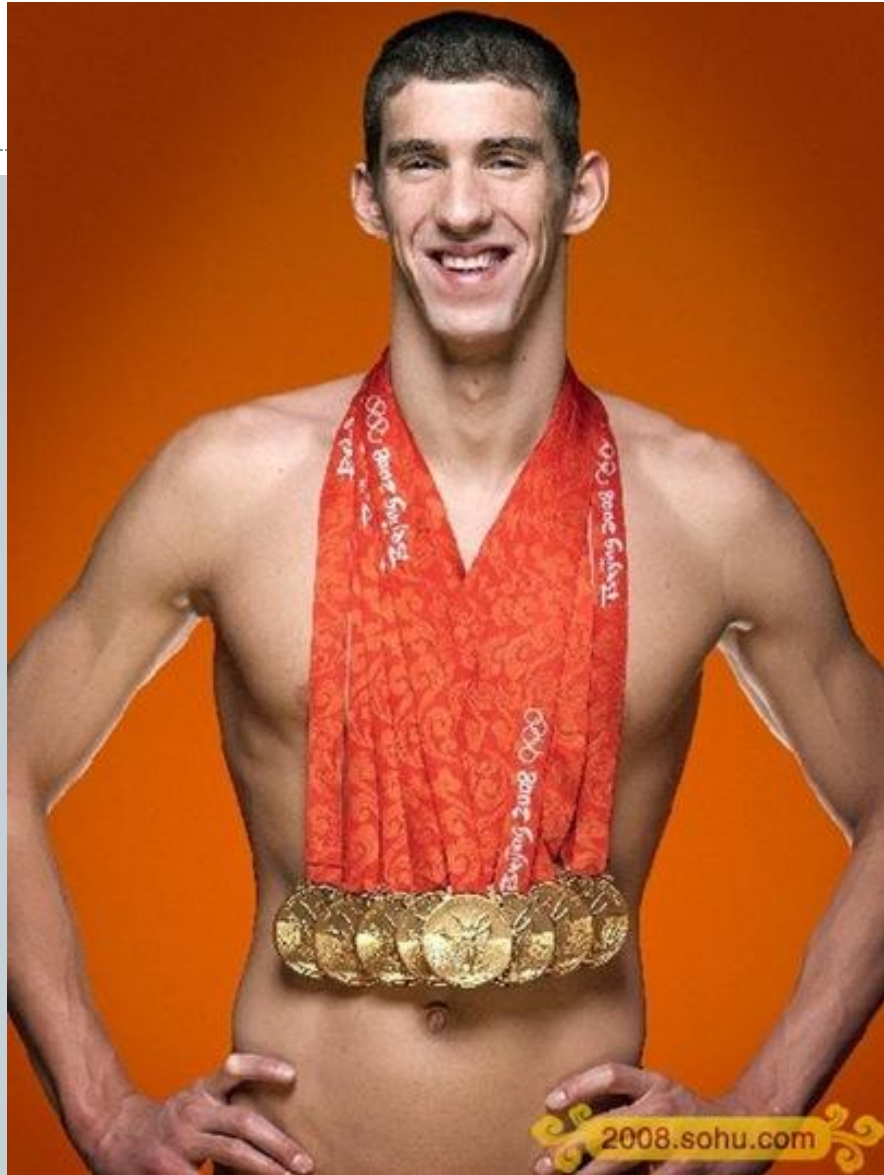

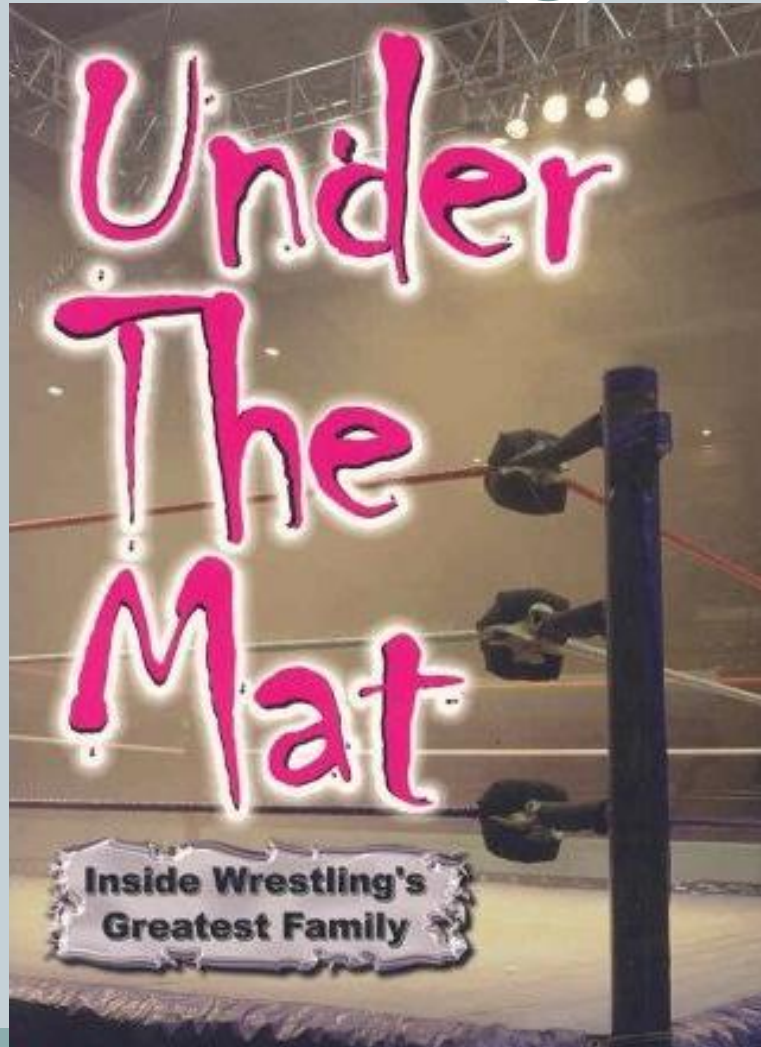

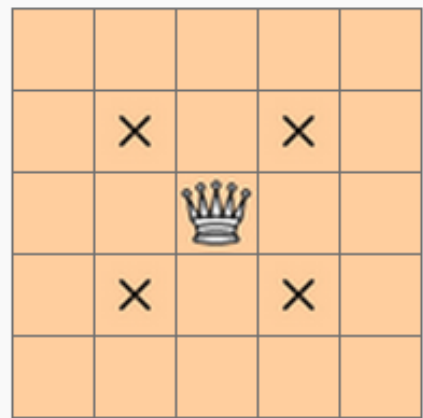


- This sport has 3 delivery styles:

- **Tweener**: Tweeners fall somewhere in between strokers and crankers

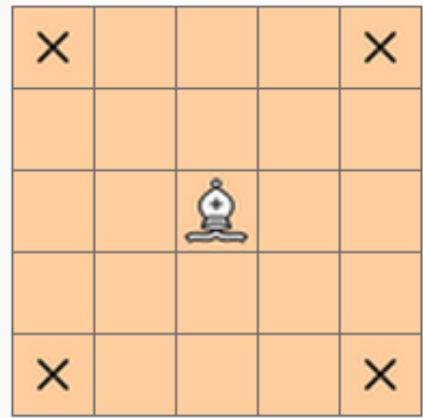
